Commissioned by Havering Community Safety Partnership, **Stephen K Patterson's Guide to a Perfect Life** uses live theatre to explore the issues and to help develop strategies and solutions for young people within a safe, inclusive environment.

The programme includes a workshop designed to engage young people in examining the choices and consequences of the characters' experiences. It asks them to think and talk about personal responsibility and potential outcomes that will help keep themselves and others safe.
